Spent Carbon Acceptance - Customer Handout

Res-Kem accepts spent or used **non-hazardous, non-RCRA Calgon** carbon at our facility in Aston.

Before the carbon can be shipped we need the following:

Carbon Acceptance Number - CAN#

Prior to transporting carbon it is necessary to obtain a Carbon Acceptance Number from Calgon. The cost for this test is \$400.00 (paid directly to Calgon). See attached Adsorbate Profile Document. Res-Kem personnel can help facilitate this but you may not use our CAN as this number covers select sites and applications.

Once the CAN is obtained the carbon can be picked up or shipped to Res-Kem Corp.

Labeling Requirements

The generator's (customer returning the carbon) CAN must be stenciled or written on each super sack and or drum.

Shipping Requirements

Each super sack must be drained of excess water and palletized on sturdy pallets. Super sacks can be purchased from Res-Kem for a nominal fee.

We do not accept drums.

Res-Kem Corp **WILL NOT** accept any carbon unless it is on a pallet and can be moved with a forklift.

Charges

Our charge for carbon return is rolled into the price of new carbon. Customers who require return service will pay slightly more per cubic foot. Please discuss this with your sales associate.

Other

Segregate carbon according to base product - **do not mix coal base with coconut base.**

We will not accept spent carbon if it is mixed with gravel or other medias.

When storing spent carbon in super sacks, we recommend that it not be exposed to excessive sunlight, as the sacks will deteriorate.

We will not accept competitor's spent carbon unless we have received an order or contract for approved Calgon products equaling the quantity to be returned.
